## WELLINGTON WALK HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

The following rules and regulations are for the protection and benefit of all members of our community. These rules have been established to assure the safe and sanitary operation of our pool. **Parents are requested to caution their children to observe all rules.** 

- 1. There should be no solo swimming
- 2. There should be no diving, running, boisterous or rough play.
- 3. No person under the influence of alcohol or drugs should use the pool.
- 4. There should be no spitting or blowing nose in pool.
- 5. Persons with diarrheal illness or nausea should not enter the pool.
- 6. All children under the age of 4 must wear CDC-approved swim diapers or "little swimmers" disposable diapers with plastic or vinyl pants over their swim diapers. There are no exceptions to this rule due to health regulations.
- 7. Persons with skin, eye, ear or respiratory infections, open lesions or wounds should not enter the pool.
- 8. No animals or pets allowed in the pool.
- 9. No glass allowed in the pool or on the deck.
- 10. Children under the age of 14 must be accompanied by an adult resident of Wellington Walk. No children should be in the pool without supervision.
- 11. You should take a shower before entering the pool.
- 12. This pool is open from 8:00 am to 10:00 pm daily.
- 13. A first aid kit is located inside both restroom areas.
- 14. An emergency phone is located on premises.
- 15. Pool & tennis courts are for the use of residents of Wellington Walk and accompanying guests only. No one shall open the entry gate for others. Each resident should use their own personal key fob for entry.
- 16. Everyone using the pool is responsible for tidying up before they leave: lower umbrellas, throw away trash, straighten chairs, don't forget personal belongings.
- \*\*\*Any person using the pool does so at his or her own risk. There is no life guard on duty. The WELLINGTON WALK HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION and the WWHOA Board of Directors will not be responsible for any accidents or injuries in connection with the use of the pool, nor any loss or damage to personal property. DO NOT BRING VALUABLES TO THE POOL.

These rules and regulations may be revised at any time at the discretion of the WWHOA Board of Directors. Any change will be posted in a clearly visible location in the pool area.
